Ways your, fundraising support helps RMHC SA

Ronald McDonald House Charities is one of Australia's most trusted charities.

Ronald McDonald House Charities South Australia (RMHC SA) has provided life-changing, holistic support, to families with seriously ill children, since 1991.

With 1 in 4 regional families having to travel to metropolitan Adelaide to receive care for their sick or injured child, RMHC SA provides free and safe accommodation, along with essential support services, less than 200m from the Women's and Children's Hospital.

It costs RMHC SA approx. \$160 to support one family, per night.

While McDonald's is our Founding and Forever Partner, after their generous support approximately 80% of our operations are unfunded.

Community support is vital to our ongoing operations, which is why we're calling on your school to help!

DID YOU KNOW?

Ronald McDonald House Charities also supports students through in-house education support by qualified teachers, as well as access to 40 hours of free tuition when the patient returns home.

Fundraising Guidelines

Name & logo use

- Ronald McDonald House Charities South Australia should only be referenced as "RMHC SA" or "Ronald McDonald House Charities South Australia".
- Be clear that your fundraiser is not being managed by RMHC SA, but is an activity held "in support of Ronald McDonald House Charities South Australia".
- Any printed matierials or advertising relating to the activity that features the RMHC SA logo must be submitted for approval.

Permits & Public Liability

- RMHC SA does not provide Public Liability Insurance for fundraisers. We suggest holding your fundraiser at a venue which is already covered by Public Liability Insurance.
- The fundraiser is responsible for sourcing any permits, licences, or authorisation from local councils, shopping centres etc., that may be required.
- Each State and Territory has legislation relating to fundraising activity. It is your responsibility to clarify and implement the charity fundraising legislative requirements of your state/territory. You can find more information here.

Media & Promotion

- Social media is a great way to promote your fundraising event or activity. Don't forget to tag us on social media so we can follow along your fundraising journey!
- All media materials that reference Ronald McDonald House Charities South Australia must be approved by RMHC SA prior to circulation.
